A Prussian (Natangian and a *witing*) **ancestor**,

 \**Talk-kāims* (Old Prussian for ‘a village of a *tolk*, an interpreter’),  
**Tollkeim** (German), spelled also **Tolckheim** (1623) – haplogroup **R1a-Z92**

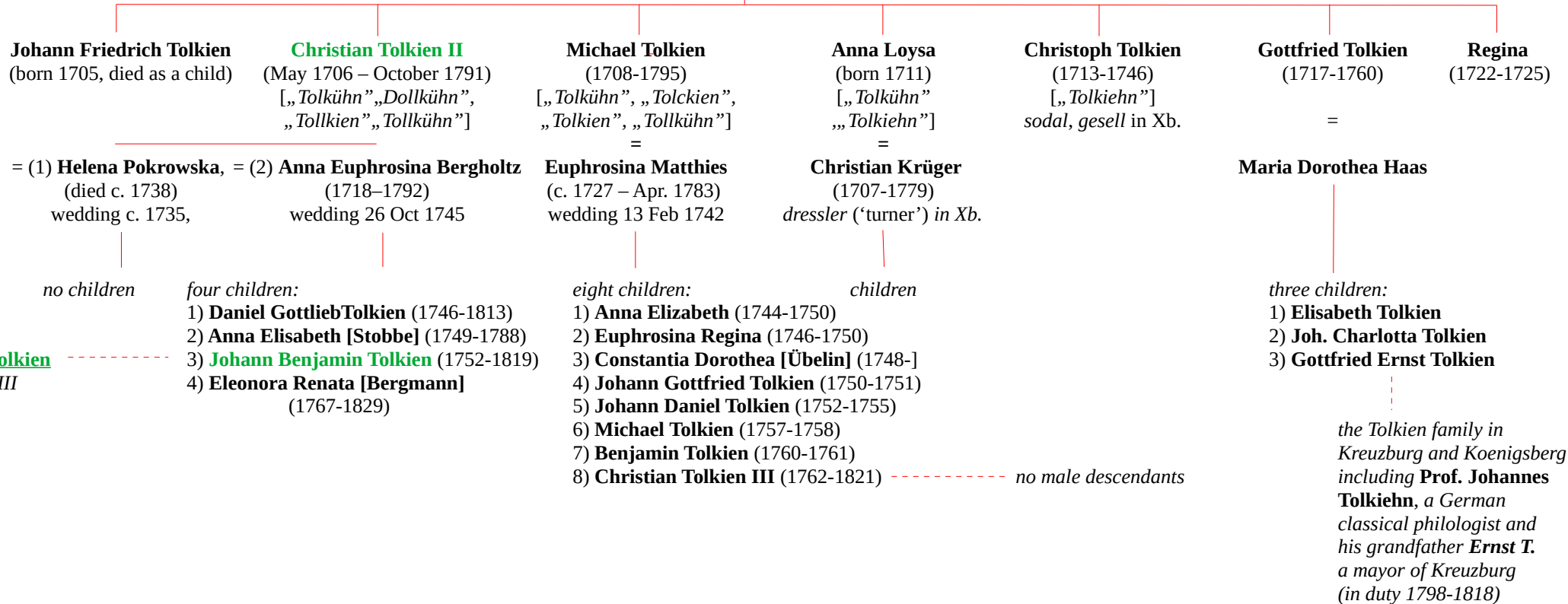
